### About the Survey

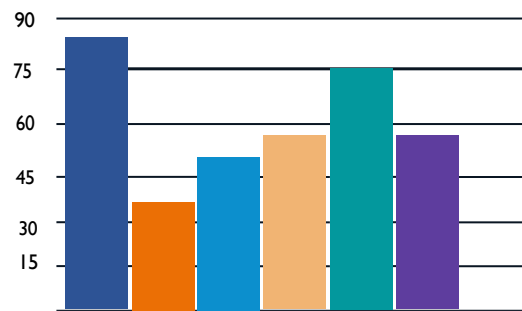
HealthEthics recently administered a survey on how best to support your organization's ethical practice. The responses are recorded below.



When communicating with others in their organization about ethical concerns or topics, most ethics committee members connected through direct contact (email, text, in-person) or through Zoom/Teams.

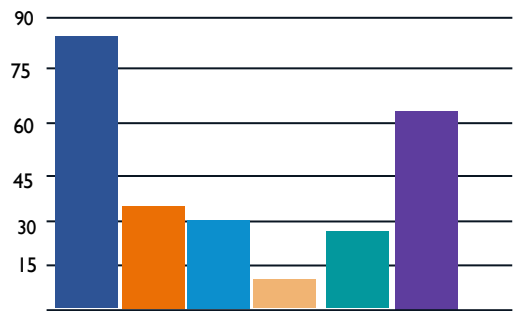
### WHEN LOOKING TO INCREASE KNOWLEDGE IN YOUR FIELD YOU USE:

- **Others in Organization 55%**



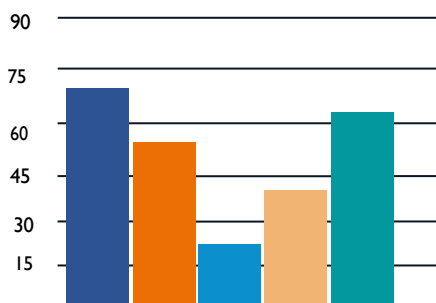
### WOULD LIKE TO SEE MORE OF THE FOLLOWING OFFERED IN THE ETHICS COMMUNITY:

- **Discussion Forums 61%**

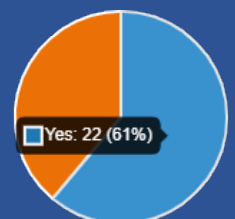


### ETHICS COMMITTEES WOULD LIKE TO SEE MORE OF THE FOLLOWING:
